SERIES 189 "BREAKING FREE FROM EVERY ADDICTION" CONFESSIONS (Scriptures used for these confessions are italicized.)

ROMANS 10:9-13; HEBREWS 7:25; COLOSSIANS 2:10; 2 CORINTHIANS 5:21

ROMANS 10.9-15, HEBRE WS 7.25, COLOSSIANS 2.10, 2 CORINTHIANS 5.21
Jesus, you are my Lord and I know that God raised you from the dead. Thank you for
saving me to the uttermost and for making intercession unto God on my behalf. You have
saved me from the shame of addiction, and my salvation is complete
there is nothing lacking in the life that I have received from you. You bore the sin of
addiction and I am now the righteousness of God. There is nothing
about my life in you, or my salvation, or my righteousness that can be addicted to
anything. I am saved from all forms of addiction!
EPHESIANS 2:8-10
Father God, I think you for honoring my faith and giving to me the gift of salvation out of
your grace. I know that none of my works earned me this salvation, and it is by your
grace that I am totally saved and delivered from addiction to I am
your workmanship, created in Christ Jesus, and your work in me is why I am completely
free from addiction. It is your will that I live everyday according to
who I am in Christ; therefore, I declare that I live everyday free from
addiction.
ROMANS 5:20
Your word makes it clear that addiction is sin. But your grace is
greater and more powerful than any addiction; it is because of the abundance of your
grace that I live totally free from addiction.
ROMANS 6:6-14; 1 CORINTHIANS 9:27
My old sin nature was crucified with you, Jesus, and the sin of
addiction was completely destroyed; I no longer serve that addiction. I am dead to that
addiction and totally free from its influence. You died on my behalf and that addiction
died with you. Now, I live daily with you and addiction has no
control over me. I am dead to that habit and behavior and it has no more control over me.
Because of you, Jesus, I am alive unto God. No addiction of any kind reigns in my body.

I never give in to the temptations presented to me by any addiction. I do not yield to the		
lure of any addiction; but rather, I daily submit to the will of God and live as an example		
of the righteousness you have made me. I have total control over my body; it is subject		
unto me and the sin of addiction does not have dominion over me.		
Because of what you have done in me, I am not under the law of an addiction, but I am		
under the authority of God's grace.		
ROMANS 8:1-2, 6, 10-17		
Jesus, I am in you and I no longer walk according to the desires of the flesh. The law of		
the spirit of life in you has made me free from addiction and it no longer		
works condemnation in my life. Even my mind is free from the thoughts of		
addiction, and now my mind is filled with your life and peace.		
Jesus, your life is in me and my body is as good as dead when it comes to controlling my		
life. However, I am alive with your spirit of life and righteousness. The life of God that		
raised you from the dead is now in me. I am no longer enslaved by		
addiction to live according to its desires. That addiction no longer works any kind of		
death in me; and through the power of your life in me I dominate all wrong desires.		
Father, I am your child and live every day according to the righteousness of your life in		
me. You have not given me a spirit that can be enslaved or addicted to anything. You		
have given me your own spirit and I am now your child.		
Holy Spirit, I thank you for daily confirming to me that I am literally God's offspring and		
a joint-heir with Jesus. God, I praise you that my inheritance includes being completely		
free from addiction.		
ROMANS 7:4		
Through the body of Christ I am dead to the control of addiction		
and now my life daily bears fruit that is pleasing unto you, God.		
JOHN 17:21-24		
I am in Christ and He is in me. I am one with God. Father, I think you for giving to me		
the same glory that you gave Jesus. I am made perfect in you. I am an example to the		
world of someone who lives in the love of God and is not hindered by		

addiction. I praise you for daily giving me a new revelation of your glory and my deliverance.

EPHESIANS 2:1-7		
I no longer live in the dead life of	_ addiction and I am no longer	
deceived by the devils that influenced me into	addiction. I do not	
fulfill the lusts of that addiction and it does not impair the way I think. My nature has		
changed and I have the life of God.		
Father, I thank you for being rich in mercy toward me and for your great love wherewith		
you love me. By your grace, you have saved me and given me the life of Christ. You		
have raised me up above addiction	on and I am now seated with Jesus	
at your right hand. Every day I live in the exceeding riches of your grace, by which I live		
free from addiction		
PHILIPPIANS 4:13; 1 John 4:13; John 8:36		
Jesus, I do all things through your life and anointing in me that strengthens me. It is by		
that strength that I live every day free from	addiction. As you are,	
so am I in the world. You are not addicted to anything; I am not addicted to anything.		
You have made me totally, completely 100% free from	addiction	
and I am free indeed!
