

DISCIPLESHIP ASSIGNMENT #1

You will need a notebook and paper, or a computer, or both.

Be sure you have listened to parts 1-10 of the discipleship series.

1. Listen to Series 105 “Meditation Produces Transformation” (only six sermons; listen to each sermon in one sitting). As you listen, follow along in scripture, pray in the Spirit and take notes.

2. Read 1st John a minimum of 50 times (it only has five chapters, 105 verses). While reading, pray in the Spirit. Do not take notes or do word studies until beginning with the 50th reading.

3. Joshua was faithful, even in battle (Exodus 17:8-16); he ended up leading Israel. Elisha was faithful & sought for a double-portion of Elijah’s spirit (anointing); he ended up stepping in to Elijah’s role (2 Kings 2)
The Apostles were faithful and ended up continuing the work of Jesus.
Timothy was faithful; he ended up continuing the work of Paul (2 Timothy).
A disciple will be faithful; when the doors are open, you’ll be here on time, ready to participate and help. Develop the mindset that you are the pastor. [Viewers will log on or watch archived services, setting aside time].

This was part of sermon #10 in the discipleship series, “Stepping Into Discipleship.” It was originally taught on Dec. 5; assignment #1 due on Feb 6 – extra time allowed re: holidays. For those who begin this assignment after January 1st, you will have 30 days to finish.
