

EXHORTATIONS AND CONFESSIONS FOR AN ELECTION

Proverbs 29:2

Joshua 24:14-15

2 Chronicles 7:14....Jeremiah 18:7-8...Jeremiah 26:12-13...Ezekiel 18:27-32

John 16:7-11

An election is just that: an election. It is not a pre-ordained move of God. It is impossible to find in scripture where God has moved on the people of a nation, violated their free will and forced them to make a decision concerning the direction of their nation.

The same is true today. Regardless of how people have misinterpreted scripture, God will not violate the will of people when it comes to voting; if He were going to do such a thing, then every vote cast would be for the person God wants in office. If God were going to violate the will of man, (1) He would have done it in the Garden of Eden. (2) Considering what Jesus did for humanity, God would force people to be born again.

Matthew 7:24-27 A nation is only as strong as its adherence to the standards of God's Word. God does not need an ungodly leader in a place of authority so He can bring judgment on a nation. God has already declared in His Word what will happen to the nation which turns from Him. Judgment has already been pronounced and it will fall on any nation that rebels against God. The more a nation turns from God, the more the elements of judgment will begin to manifest.

Why do people vote for the ungodly?

- 1) No strength of moral character.
- 2) Deteriorated sense of right and wrong.
- 3) A seared conscience.
- 4) Exalting the desires of self and the flesh over the desires of a Holy God.
- 5) Turning further and further away from the standards of the Bible.

CONFESSIONS

Hebrews 4:16 Father, I come boldly before Your throne of grace to obtain mercy and find grace to help in this great time of need. Our nation is in dire need of Your help. I need Your help. Therefore, Father, please release your grace and mercy unto me and this nation. May Your mercy and grace flow like a rushing river across this nation. May everyone, lost or saved, sense the flow of your mercy and grace.

[If He brings anything to mind, confess and repent right now.] I ask you to move by the power of Your Holy Spirit upon the hearts and minds of all the people in our nation. Even right now, may they sense an overwhelming presence of Your love, Your holiness, Your

righteousness and great conviction. May it be so strong that they call upon the Name of the Lord and are saved.

Father, please forgive me of my sin and rebellion to Your Word. Please forgive our nation for the sin and rebellion to Your Word that has been so willingly allowed and even promoted. Father, our nation was established on Your Word and faith in Jesus Christ. May the remnants of that foundation be strengthened. May the hearts of the people be turned again unto You. May the eyes of our understanding be enlightened to the hope we have in You. May even the worst of sinners begin to comprehend the need to turn from their wicked ways.

1 Timothy 2:1-4 Father, I lift up our president and all national, state and local leaders. Even though many of them have violated your Holy standards, I thank you for them. I also lift up to you all candidates for every national, state and local office. You love them and I love them. You want them saved and to come unto the knowledge of the truth, I want them saved and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.

I ask you to move upon them with great conviction over their sin and rebellion to Your Word and holiness. Keep sending laborers who are sowers, waterers and harvesters into their lives. I call them born again, filled with the Holy Spirit and attending the church You know is best for them.

Proverbs 29:2; James 1:5 Father, it is Your desire that the righteous be in authority at every level of leadership in our nation. You do not want the wicked in a position of ruling over the people. You do not force Your will on people and You do not force people to change their minds. However, you can bring to our attention what you know is best. May the presence of Your righteousness and holiness fill every place of voting. May that presence bring great conviction and may voters respond to that conviction by voting in favor of candidates You know should be elected.

May all who are elected to any office be those who will be upright before You and of a moral character; those who will protect and uphold the truth of our constitution and not alter its meaning for the purpose of promoting unrighteousness and sin. May those elected be people who will protect and support the sanctity of all life; those who will protect our rights, including the restoration and full support of all the religious right of Christians.

May the upright sit in the seats of all authority. May they hear and obey Your voice. May the wicked and treacherous be rooted out and replaced by those who will do Your will, just as happened to the wicked and treacherous in the Old Testament.

Isaiah 26:1-2 Father, may the results of this election be what pleases You. May this song be sung in our land: We are a strong nation in the holy hands of God. May your salvation be as walls and bulwarks surrounding our country. I say the United States of America is one nation under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all. Jesus is Lord over the United States of America.

Father, I thank you for a great spiritual awakening across this nation with mighty signs, wonders and miracles accompanying - all to the Glory of God the Father, His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit.
