III. THE ORIGIN OF HEALING (WHAT MAKES IT AVAILABLE)

IV. THE ORIGIN OF FAITH (FOR A CHRISTIAN)

- A. Jesus Hebrews 11:39-12:2.

V. THE APPLICATION OF HEALING

- A. Do nothing, hoping the body will heal itself.
- B. Utilize medicine and/or therapy.
- C. Claim healing provided by Jesus, pray and receive prayer, confess healing scriptures.
- D. Use a combination of faith and medicine and/or therapy.

VI. THE VARIOUS HEALING DOCTRINES OF CHRISTIANS

- A. Claim a belief in divine healing, but do nothing for its appropriation and still use medicine and/or therapy.
- B. Claim a belief in divine healing and refuse all forms of medicine and/or therapy.
- C. Selective faith for healing.
 - 1. Claim a belief in divine healing over medicine and/or therapy.
 - 2. Still use aspirin, glasses, hearing aids, heat pads, antiseptic ointment, etc.
- D. Standing on God's Word, pray, confess and worship for a manifestation of healing, yet willing to use medicine and/or therapy to enable as much daily function as possible.

VII. WHAT IS YOUR BELIEF?

- A. Faith healing is a reality, but you must have the necessary faith.
- B. The use of health insurance is not a lack of faith.
- C. Use of medicine and/or therapy is not antithetical to faith: 1 Timothy 5:23.
- D. What you willing to endure and put others through?
- E. Is your belief based on scripture and godly wisdom, or is it based on the imbalanced teachings of others?
