

WORDS FOR MEDITATION (22)

- 1) **2 Corinthians 5:7; Romans 10:17; John 17:17** A "truth-walk" does not get sidetracked or overwhelmed by emotion when praying for and ministering to people concerning: healing, deliverance, and so on. A "truth-walk" ministers to people out of a confidence of who Jesus is, the power of His name, the power of God's Word and the power of His life in you.
- 2) **1 John 4:11** Loving someone does not demand you trust the person unconditionally. It simply means you love them with My love. I do not respect the actions, words or beliefs of all My children. I know each person's heart and how much I can trust them with blessings, power and anointing. I know what you are capable of stewarding. Your maturity in Me enables Me to trust you with more of all I have to offer.
- 3) **Genesis 25:29-34** Esau sold his birthright for natural provision. Christians have a birthright in Jesus; you sell it as you pursue natural means to obtain God's promises.
- 4) **Exodus 13:21-22** You would be amazed and astonished at the sight of a glory cloud by day and a fire by night. But to the Jews who left Egypt, such a miraculous event was a common, every day experience. This is the way it was with Jesus and healing, and the way it is supposed to be for My Church.
- 5) **John 11:1-16** Thomas said, "Let us also go with Him," a declaration of his loyalty and commitment to Jesus. But he also said, "that we may die with Him," revealing his pessimism and doubt. Doubt is not a sin; it is a part of maturing that cannot instantly be removed, but is replaced by belief as you mature in truth.
- 6) **Romans 8:26-27** There is never any unbelief spoken when you pray in tongues.
- 7) **Matthew 6:9-10** God already knows how His will is to be done in the world and specifically in your life. He already sees His will being fulfilled. What you need to do is press into Him so that what He sees and knows is what manifests.
