- 1) **John 11:1-44; Romans 8:13** The moment you were born again, God's life was imparted to you. But you are the one responsible for rolling away the stone of the flesh so the life of your Father can come forth.
- 2) **Romans 6:6, 11, 18-19** Being born again gives you the power to live without adultery, pornography, drugs, alcohol, and so on. But it also gives you the power to love and forgive in every situation and relationship.
- 3) **James 1:22** The moment you say “I can’t,” or “I don’t know how,” when it comes to personal change is the moment you have begun deceiving yourself.
- 4) **Proverbs 6:2; Proverbs 18:21** Which do you think is worse: speaking four-letter expletives, or speaking unbelief in God’s Word and His promises?
- 5) **Psalms 119:89; 1 Peter 1:24-25** Nothing that happens in the natural can refute or discredit anything written in the Bible. However, what is written in the Bible can explain events in the natural.
- 6) **Proverbs 4:20-22; John 6:63** You need to grow to the point of living what you hear as opposed to having a dependency on prayer lines to try and get relief, impartation, deliverance, healing and more.
- 7) **Hebrews 6:17-19; 2 Peter 1:4** With which do you identify the most: What God has said in His Word, especially what He has said about you, or what you see in the world and what your flesh says about you?
