2 CHRONICLES 7:14

GOVERNMENTS/PRESIDENT TRUMP/THOSE IN AUTHORITY

1 Timothy 2:1-6 ¹I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; ²For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. ³For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; ⁴Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. ⁵For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; ⁶Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.

Titus 3:1-2 ¹Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, ²To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, showing all meekness unto all men.

Romans 13:1-7 ¹Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. ²Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation. ³For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? Do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same: ⁴For he is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil. ⁵Wherefore ye must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake. ⁶For for this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing. ⁷Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.

Father, we come before You on behalf of our president, Donald J. Trump. We thank You for him. He is our president and we obey Your Word and willingly make ourselves subject to him in the authority he holds in the office of president. We will not speak evil of him, we will not revile him, and we will not resist him, no matter what he says or does, for he sits in the ordained seat of authority in our nation. He is Your minister to us for good. He is not a terror to those who do good, but he is a terror to those who promote evil in our land. He is Your revenger unto wrath to those who seek for evil to rule in our nation.

reprove with equity in all that will honor You. May he stand with boldness and a rod of iron against all who oppose Your holiness and Your Word. May his words decree the standards of Your Holy Scriptures (Isaiah 11:2-4).

Many in politics, the news media, entertainment, sports and social media have increasingly risen up against him and trouble him. But You, oh Lord, are a shield for him. You are his glory and the lifter up of his head (Psalm 3:1, 3). Protect him from the secret counsel of the wicked and the insurrection of those who work iniquity. They use their tongue like a sword and their bitter words are like arrows shot at him. They encourage each other in their evil. They lie, lay snares and traps to embarrass him and do not believe anyone will uncover their plans. They do everything they can to try and find something he has done wrong so they can accuse him and bring him to shame. May their words turn upon them and be as arrows to pierce their pride and bring upon them the embarrassment, shame and humiliation they want to bring upon President Trump. May they see that the hand of God is upon our president (Psalm 64:2-9).

May President Trump turn away wrath with a soft answer and may he have the tongue of the wise, using knowledge in righteousness (Proverbs 15:1-2). May his heart be in Your hands and may he yield to Your leadership (Proverbs 21:1).

Father, may he seek to dwell in the secret place of the Most High and abide under the shadow of the Almighty. May he say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God; in Him do I trust. I ask that You deliver him from the snare of the fowler and from the noisome pestilence. Please cover him with Your feathers so that under Your wings he trusts. May he seek Your truth to be his shield and buckler. He shall not be afraid for the terror by night, nor for the arrow that flies by day, nor for the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor for the destruction that wastes at noonday.

A thousand shall fall at his side, and ten thousand at his right hand; but it shall not come near him. Only with his eyes shall he behold and see the judgment of the wicked.

Because he makes the Lord his refuge and the Most High his habitation, there shall no evil befall him, neither shall any plague come near him or his home and family.

I ask that that You give Your angels charge over him, to keep him in all his ways. May they bear him up in their hands that he suffer no injury or calamity.

He shall subdue, defeat, and thoroughly displace all those who are enemies of this nation, whether they be domestic or foreign.

I say he sets his love on You and knows Your Name; and may You deliver him and set him on high before all people and nations as an example of a God-fearing leader. I say he calls upon You in all matters, and You will answer him: You will be with him in trouble and deliver and honor him. Please satisfy him with long life and show him Your salvation. (Psalm 91)

Father, as You watch over President Trump, please also watch over his wife, Melania, his children Donald Jr., Ivanka, Eric, Tiffany, Baron and their families. I call them safe from sickness, disease, injury and any form of accident. Watch over their personal property, protecting it from theft or damage. May Your peace and presence fill their lives.
