Isaiah 60:1-5

V1 The glory of the Lord is risen upon thee John 1:1-4, 14...Romans 6:4...Philippians 3:10In My glory there is no need to fear. If Satan cannot defeat Me, he cannot defeat you. But you must be willing to engage every Goliath that comes against you. I know every strategy of the enemy and I can prepare you for all he is planning to do.

V2 darkness (choshekh) In the context of this passage: the ignorance, misery and sin of humanity. **John 1:4-5**

God is telling us we need to do verse 1 because an increase of darkness is coming.

V2 ...but the Lord shll **arise** (zârach) to irradiate (or shoot forth beams), that is, to rise (as the sun); specifically to appear (as a symptom or indication).

V2 ...and His glory **shall be seen** (râ'âh) to *see*, literally or figuratively.

V3 kings (melek) leaders; people of authority; governmental authorities.
