- Psa 7:17 I will praise the LORD according to his righteousness: and will sing praise to
- the name of the LORD most high.
- **Psa 9** ¹I will praise thee, O LORD, with my whole heart; I will show forth all thy marvelous works. ²I will be glad and rejoice in thee: I will sing praise to thy name, O thou most High.
- Psa 13:6 I will sing unto the LORD, because he hath dealt bountifully with me.
- Psa 18:49 Therefore will I give thanks unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and sing praises unto thy name.
- Psa 21:13 Be thou exalted, LORD, in thine own strength: so will we sing and praise thy power.
- **Psa 27:6** And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD.
- Psa 30 ⁴Sing unto the LORD, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness. ¹²To the end that my glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee for ever.
- **Psa 33** ¹Rejoice in the LORD, O ve righteous: for praise is comely for the upright. ²Praise the LORD with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery and an instrument of ten strings. ³Sing unto him a new song; play skilfully with a loud noise.
- **Psa 47** ⁶Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises. ⁷For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.
- **Psa 57** My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed: I will sing and give praise. ⁸Awake up, my glory; awake, psaltery and harp: I myself will awake early. 9I will praise thee, O Lord, among the people: I will sing unto thee among the nations.
- **Psa 59** ¹⁶But I will sing of thy power; yea, I will sing aloud of thy mercy in the morning: for thou hast been my defense and refuge in the day of my trouble. ¹⁷Unto thee, O my strength, will I sing: for God is my defense, and the God of my mercy.
- **Psa 61:8** So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, that I may daily perform my vows.

- **Psa 63** ³Because thy lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise thee. ⁴Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name. ⁵My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise thee with joyful lips:
- **Psa 66** ¹Make a joyful noise unto God, all ye lands: ²Sing forth the honour of his name: make his praise glorious.
- **Psa 68** ³But let the righteous be glad; let them rejoice before God: yea, let them exceedingly rejoice. ⁴Sing unto God, sing praises to his name: extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name JAH, and rejoice before him.
- **Psa 71** ⁸Let my mouth be filled with thy praise and with thy honour all the day. ²²I will also praise thee with the psaltery, even thy truth, O my God: unto thee will I sing with the harp, O thou Holy One of Israel. ²³My lips shall greatly rejoice when I sing unto thee; and my soul, which thou hast redeemed.
- **Psa 75:9** But I will declare for ever; I will sing praises to the God of Jacob.
- **Psa 81:1** Sing aloud unto God our strength: make a joyful noise unto the God of Jacob.
- **Psa 89:1** I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations.
- **Psa 92:1** It is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:
- **Psa 95** ¹O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. ²Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms. ³For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.
- **Psa 96** ¹O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth. ²Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; show forth his salvation from day to day.
- **Psa 98** ¹O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvelous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory. ⁴Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise. ⁵Sing unto the LORD with the harp; with the harp, and the voice of a psalm.
- Psa 101:1 I will sing of mercy and judgment: unto thee, O LORD, will I sing.
- **Psa 104:33** I will sing unto the LORD as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.
- **Psa 105** ¹O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon his name: make known his deeds among the people. ²Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him: talk ye of all his wondrous works.

Psa 108 ¹O God, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory. ³I will praise thee, O LORD, among the people: and I will sing praises unto thee among the nations.

Psa 119:171 My lips shall utter praise, when thou hast taught me thy statutes.

Psa 135 ¹Praise ye the LORD. Praise ye the name of the LORD; praise him, O ye servants of the LORD. ²Ye that stand in the house of the LORD, in the courts of the house of our God, ³Praise the LORD; for the LORD is good: sing praises unto his name; for it is pleasant.

Psa 138 ¹I will praise thee with my whole heart: before the gods will I sing praise unto thee. ²I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth: for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name. ³In the day when I cried thou answeredst me, and strengthenedst me with strength in my soul. ⁴All the kings of the earth shall praise thee, O LORD, when they hear the words of thy mouth. ⁵Yea, they shall sing in the ways of the LORD: for great is the glory of the LORD.

Psa 144:9 I will sing a new song unto thee, O God: upon a psaltery and an instrument of ten strings will I sing praises unto thee.

Psa 146 ¹Praise ye the LORD. Praise the LORD, O my soul. ²While I live will I praise the LORD: I will sing praises unto my God while I have any being.

Psa 147 ¹Praise ye the LORD: for it is good to sing praises unto our God; for it is pleasant; and praise is comely. ³He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds. ⁴He telleth the number of the stars; he calleth them all by their names. ⁵Great is our Lord, and of great power: his understanding is infinite. ⁶The LORD lifteth up the meek: he casteth the wicked down to the ground. ⁷Sing unto the LORD with thanksgiving; sing praise upon the harp unto our God:
