WORDS FOR MEDITATION (24)

- 1) **Hebrews 5:12-14 & 1 Corinthians 14:4** If you cut off the supply line to a battalion, they will eventually begin to eat anything they can find. They are still a part of the army and still following their commander in that they have not turned their backs on him. But they are not being nourished for the battle. Too much of the Body of Christ is malnourished.
- 2) **Revelation 2:1, 8, 12, 18, 3:1, 7, 14** If your church or your life were a book in the Bible, what would it say?
- 3) Romans 8:32 & Ephesians 1:3 When you are born again, God's life brings with it access to everything promised. But until you reach out to believe for, access and appropriate the promises, they will not manifest. Understanding this will eliminate feeling the need to repeatedly get in prayer lines. Too many Christians want prayer lines to be a substitute for spiritual growth.
- 4) **Hebrews 13:5-6 & 1 Peter 5:7** It is very difficult for God to solve problems you have wrapped in your arms.
- 5) **Hebrews 9:11-12, 14-18** Under the new covenant, there is never any conviction for sins that have been purged by the blood of Jesus. Once purged, there is no more offering for sin. You can repent over and over for old sin, but there is nothing that can be done because that old sin no longer exists: the blood of Jesus has permanently removed that sin. You will never be convicted over that which does not exist. Repenting for non-existent sin is a waste of time.
- 6) **Jeremiah 29:11 & Acts 7:57-8:1, 20:26 & Philippians 3:13-14** God knew how you were before you were saved. His grace takes you past your past and into the future He has planned for you. Too many Christians call themselves what they were instead of who they are. What is your confession of you?
