LOVE IS AN ACTION – Confessions – Walking in Obedience and Love

Lord, I pray that You would strengthen me with might by Your Spirit in the inner man; that Christ would dwell in my heart by faith; that I would be rooted and grounded in love and be able to comprehend what is the breadth and length and depth and height; and to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge so that I might be filled with all the fullness of God. (Eph. 3:16-18)

Thank You Lord for Your wisdom and Your peace. Thank You that You are with me and helping me to conform my mind to Your complete truth (Romans 12:2). I will not be satisfied with anything less. I say that I have the mind of Christ, and I will trust in You Lord (1 Cor. 2:16). I will not rely on my own strength or wisdom but will live a life fully submitted to You my heavenly Father (Proverbs 3:5-7). Lord, let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your Sight O Lord my strength and my redeemer. (Psalm 19:14)
